*Traffic codes: **EMERGENCY** = involves life/death urgency in the absence of regular commercial communications. Includes official messages of welfare agencies requesting supplies, materials, or instructions vital to relief efforts for the stricken populace in emergency areas. *When in doubt, do not use this designation.*

Priority = Important messages having a specific time limit, official messages that are not covered in the emergency category, press dispatches, and emergency-related traffic not of the utmost urgency. **WELFARE** = inquiry about the **health and welfare** of individuals **in a disaster area** or to advise **from** a disaster area that all is well. Welfare is handled only after all Emergency/Priority traffic is passed. **ROUTINE**=should be handled last or not at all in the event of busy higher precedence traffic

NTS=traffic passed to NATIONAL TRAFFIC System.

For all nets, except **Activations and SET**, place a check mark or X in the TIME IN block. For ACTIVATIONS and SET, use the Time checked in/out instead of a check mark or X for man-hour calculations.

**Man Hours: For Training, multiply the number of check-ins by the total net minutes and divide by sixty. Don't forget to include yourself. ex. A training net had 15 check-ins and lasted 35 minutes. (15 check-ins plus NCS=16), times 35 minutes=560/60=9.33 man- hours.

For Activations, add the minutes for all check ins (using Time In and Time Out), then multiply by the number of check-ins and divide by 60. Once again, count yourself. You may also add 60 minutes for yourself for preparation and reporting.

* Reminder: Storm Spotter Reports are only for reports of hail (by size), wind damage, funnel clouds, tornado on the ground and flooding **going to** the National Weather Service (NWS). **NWS Updates** are weather Watches and Warnings **from** NWS. **All Storm Spotter Reports should be immediately forwarded to the National Weather Service by the SKYWARN Liaison using the most expedient means. If no Liaison is on frequency, the NCS should pass the traffic**
